Where to turn... Whether they want advice on retirement planning or need to learn new skills, Philadelphia-area residents age 50 and older can find volunteer and educational opportunities along with leisure guides and other resources at comingofage.org

The new site, developed by the Coming of Age coalition, includes links to health, caregiving and financial planning information as well as local career resources and lists of sporting events and concerts in the Philadelphia area. The effort to develop the site began three years ago through a partnership among AARP Pennsylvania, the Temple University Center for Intergenerational Learning, PBS station WHYY and United Way of Southeastern Pennsylvania.

In neighboring Delaware, AARP is working with WHYY to develop a similar website serving Wilmington's 50-plus population.
